


PANORAMED AT A GLANCE

PANORAMED is a **governance platform** that supports the process of strengthening and developing multilateral cooperation frameworks in the **Mediterranean region** for joint responses to common challenges and opportunities. It constitutes Axis 4 of the EU's Interreg Mediterranean Programme.

- From July 2017 to April 2022

WHERE DOES PANORAMED COME FROM?

PANORAMED is funded by the Interreg MED Programme, which is the **European Territorial Cooperation (ETC)** branch that provides a framework for the implementation of joint actions and policy exchanges between national, regional and local actors from the **North shore of the Mediterranean basin**. The overarching objective of the Programme is to support **EU cohesion policy** goals as well as to promote a sustainable development in the area concerned.

- 1 Innovation

- E 3 Natural and cultural resources
- S 4 Governance



HOW DOES PANORAMED WORK?

PANORAMED establishes a **permanent dialogue** among national and regional public authorities and stakeholders for the definition of shared approaches, policies and strategic projects.

It also allows the set-up of **transnational thematic working groups** involving strategic key actors to identify shared policy approaches and strategic top-down projects. They constantly seek **synergies and complementarities** with the main institutions and initiatives active in the Mediterranean.

In 2019, PANORAMED will be working on 3 strategic themes:

1. **coastal & maritime sustainable tourism**
2. **maritime surveillance**
3. **innovation**

PANORAMED provides opportunities to organize **high-level events** to improve governance in the Mediterranean, and to promote the preparation of **strategic projects** through dissemination events in each country and the launch of Terms of Reference.

The strategic projects are “**multilevel**” **projects** implemented by partners able to influence and better define policies. The actions foreseen converge towards a common objective of **territorial development** and showcase good examples of regional cooperation. On this basis, the strategic projects will be implemented following an integrated, inclusive and participative approach. This means that the projects will facilitate the launch and reinforcement of a broader process that could be of interest for all the territories of the 12 Mediterranean countries participating to PANORAMED, involving all the relevant regional and local institutions as well as the local communities and the civil society.
